Ability to drive to and from work locations; work outdoors while exposed to traffic conditions to include dirt, noise, uneven surfaces, high-speed traffic, high volume traffic, and inclement weather. Lift, carry, install, remove, and operate traffic data collection equipment and various hand tools up to 25lbs. Stooping, bending, kneeling, crouching, pushing, pulling, reaching, twisting, and working on uneven ground.

Must be able to develop and maintain cooperative working relationships with other members of the Traffic Monitoring Group as well as with other Caltrans functional units.
