



Buser Memorial Scholarship

Annual Scholarship for Land Surveying Students

Undergraduate surveying majors at any two or four year college in California are eligible to apply. The scholarship is given in memory of Calle Buser who was a District 7 Land Surveyor killed at his work site by an errant vehicle.

The yearly scholarship schedule is as follows:

Application Material Posted:	August - September
Applications Accepted:	Postmarked September 15th - December 1st.
Selections Made:	December - January
Scholarships Awarded:	January

Applicant must;

1. Be currently enrolled as an undergraduate in a Land Surveying related degree/program at a California based College or University.
2. Have a minimum cumulative college Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 at the end of the spring semester/quarter of the year previous to the scholarship year. Freshman students should use their high school GPA.
3. Intend to pursue a career in Land Surveying. (Intent for career to be related to transportation given extra consideration.)

Awarded Yearly

4 - \$1,000 Scholarships: one each to a freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior.
